# THE COOPERATIVE PROGRAM (CP)

In Nevada, 50% of the monies given to CP remain in Nevada to help fund ministries here while the other 50% is sent on to help fund ministries throughout North America and the world. The following slides serve to explain the impact CP has for the gospel.

# INDIVIDUALS



People give tithes and offerings to their local SBC churches.

# LOCAL CHURCH



The local church uses tithes and offerings to support their ministries and, through CP, they send a portion of these tithes and offerings to NBC.

# NEVADA BAPTIST CONVENTION



50% of CP funds support ministries through NBC and 50% is sent to impact North America and the world through entities such as NAMB and IMB.

# SOUTHERN BAPTIST CONVENTION



CP funds given to SBC  
support 6 seminaries,  
ERLC, NAMB,  
and IMB.

# NORTH AMERICA



SBC sends CP funds to NAMB to support church plants, hunger ministries and other efforts to impact North America with the gospel.
