THE COOPERATIVE PROGRAM (CP)

This effort is a distinctive for Southern Baptist churches and it helps to maximize the impact of the local church in Nevada, around North America and the world.

THE COOPERATIVE PROGRAM (CP)

In Nevada, 50% of the monies given to CP remain in Nevada to help fund ministries here while the other 50% is sent on to help fund ministries throughout North America and the world. The following slides serve to explain the impact CP has for the gospel.

INDIVIDUALS



People give tithes and offerings to their local SBC churches.

LOCAL CHURCH



The local church uses tithes and offerings to support their ministries and, through CP, they send a portion of these tithes and offerings to NBC.

NEVADA BAPTIST CONVENTION



50% of CP funds support ministries through NBC and 50% is sent to impact North America and the world through entities such as NAMB and IMB.

SOUTHERN BAPTIST CONVENTION



CP funds given to SBC support 6 seminaries, ERLC, NAMB, and IMB.

SBC sends CP funds to IMB to support international missionaries and ministries to impact the world with the gospel.
